## **Speaker:**

**Gerlind Wallon** is the deputy director of the European Molecular Biology Organization (EMBO). A German native, she graduated with a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from Brandeis University, Waltham, Massachusetts, USA, followed by a 4-year postdoc at the EMBL in Heidelberg.

At EMBO she is responsible for the EMBO Young Investigator Network, the EMBO Courses and Workshops, and the Women in Science activities. Gerlind Wallon has developed the EMBO Laboratory Management Courses for leadership development and authored studies on the selection processes and the effects of gender on application success at EMBO and a report on the use of quotas in academia.
